MARLENE'S MUSINGS

--I had the opportunity to represent Virginia as Mother of the Year at the National American Mothers convention in Omaha, Nebraska, this past weekend. We spent most of Friday afternoon hunkered down in a hall in the basement of the hotel while those horrible tornadoes blew through, one of them threatening to touch down across the street.

This group was one of the most diverse groups of women I have ever met with. We were of different faiths—and no faiths—different political parties, different economic backgrounds, different races. Our families all looked different—there were widows, divorced women, women in blended families, newlyweds and oldyweds (like me). Women who had endured unspeakable tragedies—a murdered child, one whose child died in a fire at 15 months old, women with children—even multiple children—with special needs.

And yet here we were, in the corridor in the basement of a hotel, with a common love—a love of our families. And that commonality forged friendships in a short amount of time.

Women were sharing videos that friends and family members were sharing as we waited for news of what was happening "out there." One showed the video her sister sent from the porch of her house. Her roof was gone and all

the houses on the other side of the street were completely wiped out. Whole neighborhoods were destroyed. And in a moment, lives were changed.

Yet, by the time I drove back to where I was staying, the sun was shining. The route on the road I took showed no signs of what had passed through. I would have been completely oblivious had I not seen and heard the stories shared in that basement.

Which is my point. On the surface, when I first met these women, I may have supposed they had carefree lives. But as they began to share their stories, women I wouldn't have thought I had anything in common with deeply touched my heart. You never know what is going on "beneath the surface."

In a world of divisions and contentions, it's our motherhood that can bring us together. And then as we share our real stories, hearts can be knit together that can withstand any storm that may come our way.
